

Documentation Checklist - Norwegian Maritime Rules and Regulations Training Course

To be eligible to apply for a Documentary Evidence, this course must be completed under supervision, either onboard or onshore within the offices of a registered shipping company or recognised maritime institution. The following documents must be submitted to support your application:

- ☐ Certificate Application Form completed by the candidate and authenticating person
- ☐ Copy of ID (e.g. passport) of the person signing the documents (authenticating person)
- ☐ Copy of ID (e.g. passport) of candidate
- ☐ Norwegian Citizens: please submit ID with P- or D-number, this is required by the Norwegian Maritime Authority
- ☐ Copy of verification of training #4150. For this course, you must achieve:
 - 95 % (or more) completion within the last 12 months
 - 75 % score (or above) in the assessment
- ☐ Answers to all workbook questions

All documents (e.g. test print outs, written assignments, passport etc.) should be scanned or photographed using a suitable device:

Flatbed Scanner

- Ensure the scan resolution is sufficient to capture all details clearly in colour.

Digital Camera

- Ensure the photographer captures all details clearly, without shadow or glare
- Documents should be placed on a plain background
- All photographs should be in colour

Mobile Device (e.g. Smartphone or Tablet computer)

- Ensure the photographer captures all details clearly without shadow or glare
- Documents should be placed on a plain background
- All photographs should be in colour
- You may wish to download an Apple or Android App (for example CamScanner or PhotoScan) to assist you in capturing images of documents.
